

RESOLUTION NO. 1797

A RESOLUTION IDENTIFYING ELIGIBLE PROJECTS UNDER METRO'S LOCAL NATURAL AREA LEGACY FUND AS PART OF THE NOVEMBER 2006 NATURE IN NEIGHBORHOODS BOND MEASURE.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Metro council intends to place a \$220 million parks and open space bond measure on the November 2006 ballot, with a portion of the bond money going directly to local governments for use on eligible projects.
2. If the bond measure is approved, Troutdale is expected to receive approximately \$591,000 of local share money, which Metro is calling the Local Natural Area Legacy Fund.
3. The Metro council is asking each local jurisdiction to submit its list of projects that are eligible for funding under the Local Natural Area Legacy Fund so the projects can become part of the total bond package made known to the voters before the November election.
4. The City desires to identify projects for funding by the Local Natural Area Legacy Fund.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The City of Troutdale submits the following projects as candidates for use of local share bond money under the proposed 2006 Metro Nature in Neighborhoods bond measure.

1. Acquisition of natural areas on the West and Southeast side of Troutdale.
2. Construction of a pedestrian path adjacent to the Sandy River on the City's former sewage treatment plant (STP) property.
3. Improvements to the Mt. Hood Community College natural area.
4. Upgrade and repairs to existing trail system within the Beaver Creek Greenway.

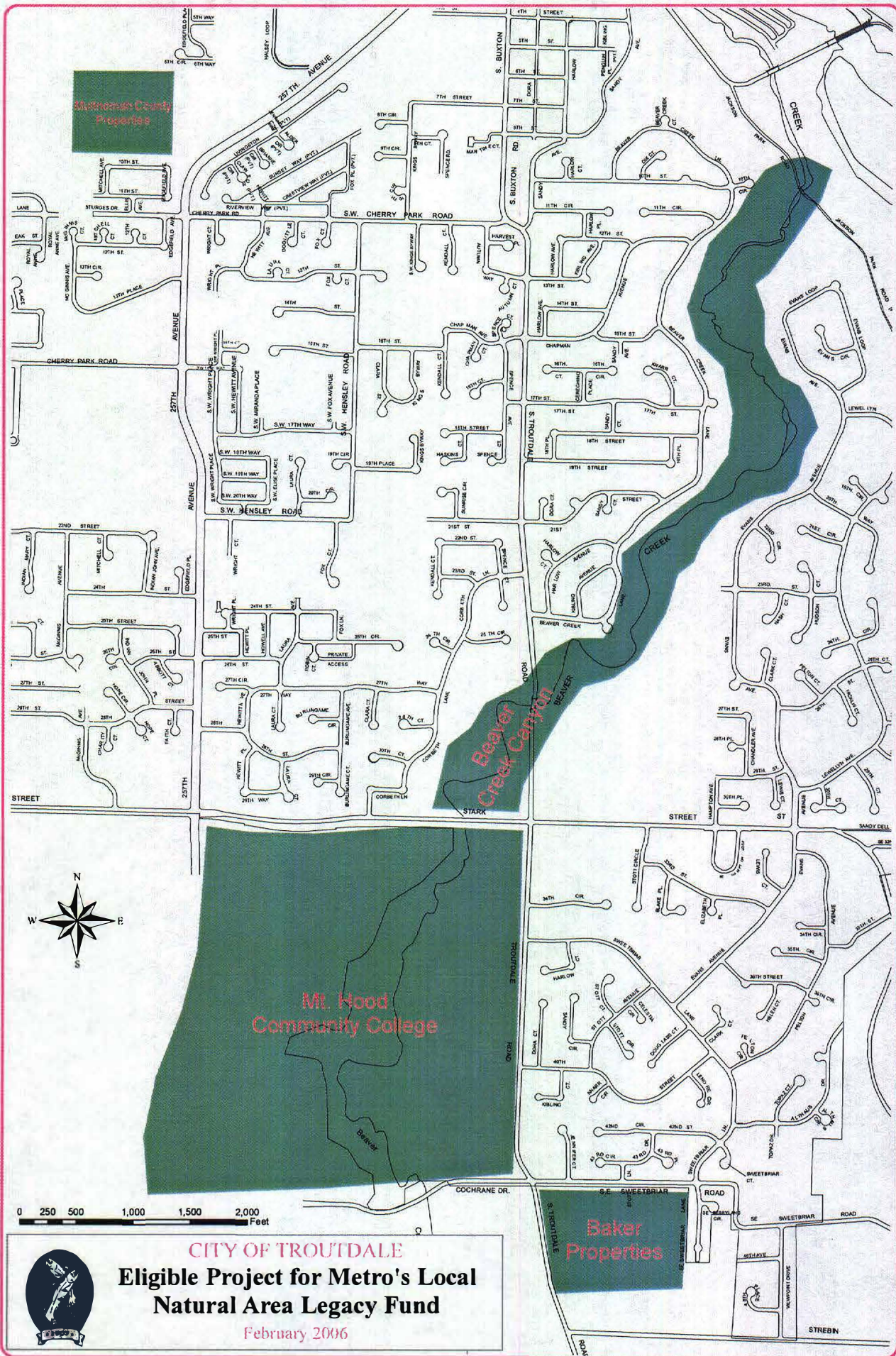
Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
