

RESOLUTION NO. 1915

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE STURGES BIKE/PED PATH AND ACCEPTING IT INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. A pathway for bicycles and pedestrians between SW Sturges Lane and SW Sturges Drive was included in the 2005 update to the Transportation System Plan and funded in the FY 2007-08 adopted budget's Street Improvement Fund.
2. The pathway was designed by All County Surveyors and Planners of Sandy and constructed by Universal Excavation Contractors of Troutdale.
3. These public improvements have been constructed in accordance with the construction contract documents.
4. Since the pathway is not within a public right-of-way, it will be maintained by the Parks and Facilities Division using General Fund monies.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The following public improvements associated with the Sturges Bike/Ped Path project are accepted into the City's fixed asset system:

<u>Improvement</u>	<u>Estimated Value</u>
Approximately 300 LF of 8-foot wide concrete pathway including 2 ADA ramps.	\$ 35,642
Approximately 440 SF of gravity stone retaining wall	\$ 11,381
Total	\$ 47,023

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
