

RESOLUTION NO. 1923

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE REQUEST FOR TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT FUNDS FOR THE TROUTDALE ROAD SIDEWALK INFILL PROJECT

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Oregon Department of Transportation is soliciting Transportation Enhancement project proposals for program years 2011, 2012, and 2013.
2. Funds are available for twelve Transportation Enhancement activities. Typical projects include sidewalks and streetscapes, bike lanes, shared-use paths, viewpoints, interpretive sites, and historic preservation of transportation facilities.
3. Staff has recommended that the City use its one allowed application for the Troutdale Road Sidewalk Infill project to improve the safety and convenience of pedestrians walking in that area, including students at Troutdale Elementary School, migrant workers, users of the 40-Mile Loop, riders of Tri-Met bus line 80, and others.
4. The City will be required to provide matching funds in the amount of no less than 10.27% of the total project cost if the application is approved.
5. A City Council resolution of support for the project is required as part of the application packet.
6. This resolution is intended to be that supporting document.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The Troutdale City Council strongly supports the request for Transportation Enhancement funds for the Troutdale Road Sidewalk Infill project and urges the Oregon Department of Transportation to approve the application.

Section 2. The Troutdale City Council will make matching funds available if the application is approved.

Section 3. This resolution is effective immediately upon its adoption.



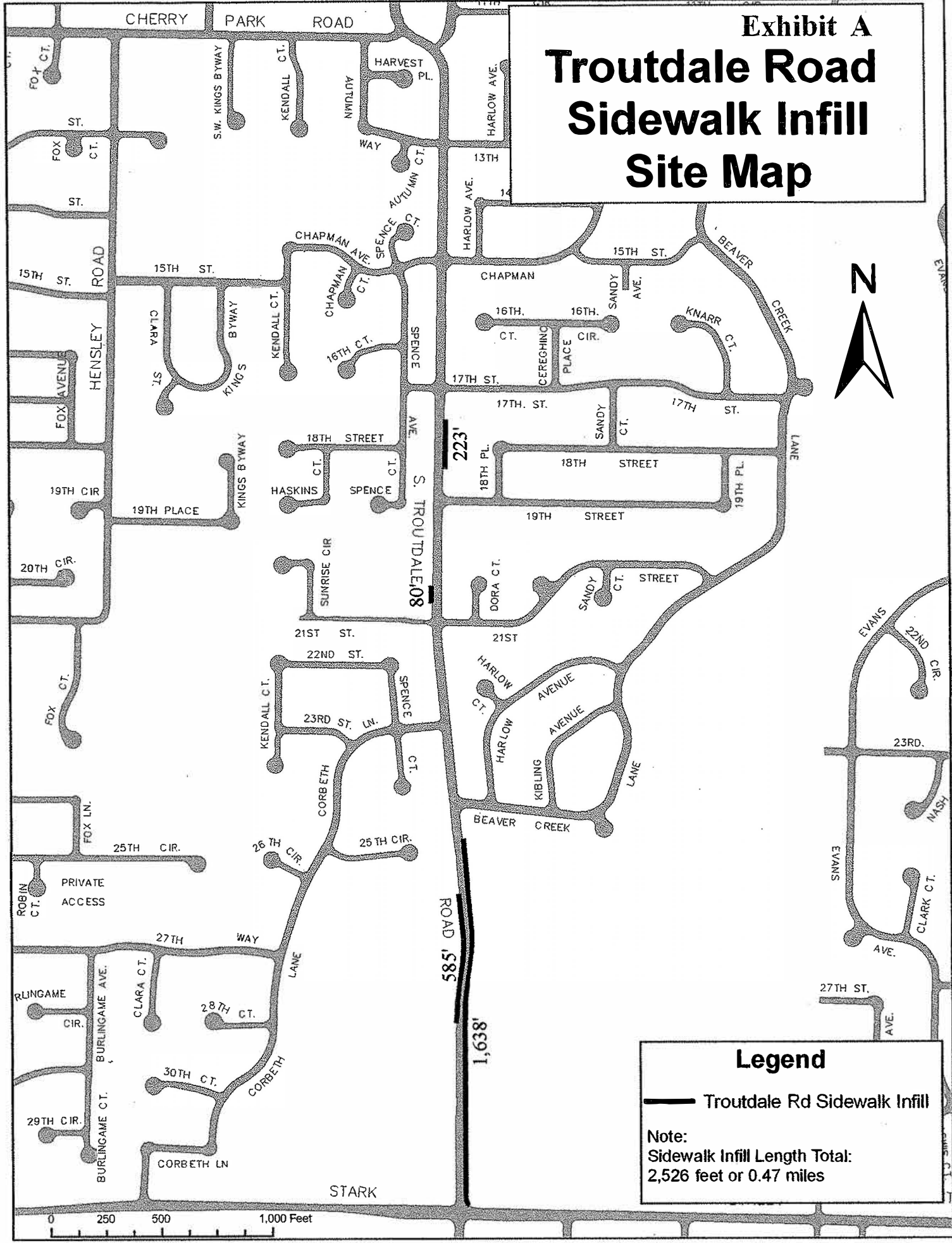
