

RESOLUTION NO. 1942

A RESOLUTION INCREASING THE WATER COMMODITY FEE AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 1872

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 12.03.030 of the Troutdale Municipal Code establishes a water utility fee and authorizes the Council to change the amount of the fee by Resolution.
2. The current water user fees were established by Resolution No. 1872 dated May 8, 2007 and effective July 1, 2007.
3. Since the enactment of Resolution No. 1872, there have been increases in the costs of personnel, materials, services, and reimbursements to other funds. In addition, the City has drilled one new well, intends to drill a second new well and construct two new well houses, with approximately seventy-five percent of the costs coming from the Water Fund. The water commodity charge increased by this Resolution is intended to help meet those increased costs.
4. No adjustment is proposed for any charges other than the commodity charge.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The water user fees are as follows:

- A. Water Commodity Charge: \$2.45 per thousand gallons.
- B. Water Meter Installation Charge:
 1. For a 3/4" meter: \$235
 2. For a 1" meter: \$285
 3. For meters larger than 1": Installed by owner.
- C. Stand Pipe Charge: \$50 (3/4" only). This is for single family home construction only. The rate is for up to 90 days. For each additional 90-day period or fraction thereof, there is an additional charge of \$50.
- D. Hydrant Meter Rental Charge: A refundable deposit of \$100 is required. There is a minimum rental charge of \$25.00 plus \$1.00 per day for each day in excess of 25 days, plus metered water usage at the water commodity charge of \$2.45 per thousand gallons.
- E. Monthly Standby Fire Service with a detector check meter:

1 ½ "	\$6.00
2"	\$9.64
3"	\$18.19
4"	\$30.36
6"	\$61.45
8"	\$96.91
10"	\$136.00

F. Monthly Standby Fire Service without a detector check meter: Twice the rate given in Paragraph E above.


Section 2. Resolution No. 1872 is rescinded effective July 1, 2008.

Section 3. This resolution is effective July 1, 2008.


