

## RESOLUTION NO. 1952

### A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE 242<sup>nd</sup> (HOGAN) AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN THE 2010-13 MTIP AND COMMITTING TO THE FUNDING OF A LOCAL MATCH

#### THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Project Number 10397 in the Regional Transportation Plan's Financially Constrained List would improve 242<sup>nd</sup> (Hogan) Avenue between Stark Street and Glisan Street (Cherry Park Road) by constructing a center turn lane, adding sidewalks and bike lanes where missing, and installing a traffic signal at SW 23<sup>rd</sup> Street if warranted.
2. Metro is currently calling for projects for the 2010-13 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP). Project Number 10397 qualifies for that program.
3. Since a portion (approximately 75%) of this section of 242<sup>nd</sup> (Hogan) Avenue lies within the City limits of Gresham and a portion (approximately 25%) lies within the City limits of Troutdale, the cities agree to share funding of the local match of \$500,000 in the same ratio.

#### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The City of Troutdale strongly supports the 242<sup>nd</sup> (Hogan) Avenue Improvement Project and urges the Joint Policy Advisory Committee on Transportation (JPACT) and the Metro Council to include the project in the 2010-13 MTIP.


Section 2. The City of Troutdale commits to funding twenty-five (25) percent of the local match for this project, up to a maximum of \$125,000.
