

## **RESOLUTION NO. 1960**

### **A RESOLUTION PERMITTING USE OF DESIGNATED CITY PARKS AS OUTDOOR RECREATIONAL AREAS UNDER ORS 105.682**

#### **THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. ORS 105.682 provides immunity to property owners who directly or indirectly allow their properties to be used for recreational purposes.
2. All City-owned and City-operated parks, recreational areas and open spaces have historically been used as outdoor recreational areas since their respective inceptions.
3. The City Council has determined that it should expressly and formally permit use of its parks as outdoor recreational areas to insure that the City may avail itself of the liability protections afforded by ORS 105.682.
4. The Troutdale City Council desires to permit recreational use of designated City parks consistent with ORS 105.682.


#### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:**

Section 1. The Troutdale City Council hereby permits recreational use of the following designated City-owned and/or City-operated parks, recreational areas and open spaces, as specified under ORS 105.682, and as consistent with other areas in the City generally regarded as outdoor recreational areas. The Council designated areas are as follows:

Columbia Park, Glen Otto Park, Sunrise Park, Depot Park, Harlow House/Barn Lawn & Trail Area, Mayor Square, C.P. Park, Sweetbriar Park, Burlingame East, Helen Althaus Park, Kiku Park, Lewellyn Park, Sandee Palisades Park, Weedin Park, Woodale Park, Beaver Creek Greenway (open space), Sandy River Greenway (open space), Sandee Palisades Detention Basin Area, Strawberry Meadows Detention Basin Area, Stuart Ridge Detention Basis Area, all City-owned and/or City-operated Pedestrian Connectors/Trails, all City-owned and/or City-operated MHCC and Metro Natural Areas.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
