

## **RESOLUTION #1975**

### **A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING THE USE OF ALCOHOL AT THE SAM COX BUILDING, AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 1787.**

#### **THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The consumption of alcohol by groups and/or individuals renting the Sam Cox Building raised concerns about City liability and degradation of the facility.
2. In November 2005 the Parks Advisory Committee (PAC) recommended that they further study the issue regarding alcohol consumption in conjunction with rental of the building. The PAC felt it necessary to prohibit the use of alcohol while this issue was being studied.
3. On November 8, 2005 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 1787 prohibiting the use of alcohol by groups renting the Sam Cox Building while the PAC further studied the issues relating to alcohol consumption within the Sam Cox Building. The prohibition of the use of alcohol at the Sam Cox Building was to remain in effect until the Council took action on the recommendation of the PAC at the conclusion of their study.
4. On October 10, 2006 the Council considered the PAC's recommendation which was to permit alcohol consumption and to adopt language to regulate alcohol consumption in city buildings. After hearing testimony at the October 10<sup>th</sup> meeting the Council did not concur with the PAC's recommendation and instead the majority of the Council felt that the prohibition on alcohol should remain in effect. The Council, by motion, made the moratorium on alcohol at the Sam Cox Building permanent.
5. Resolution No. 1787, which put a temporary prohibition on alcohol at the Sam Cox Building, remains in effect. Adopting this resolution will rescind Resolution No. 1787 and make the prohibition on alcohol at the Sam Cox Building permanent.


#### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE**


**Section 1.** The Council hereby prohibits the use of alcohol within the Sax Cox Building.

**Section 2.** Resolution No. 1787 is rescinded effective upon adoption of this resolution.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
