

RESOLUTION NO. 1980

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESIGNEE, AS CO-MANAGER OF THE COLUMBIA CASCADE ENTERPRISE ZONE

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. On September 11, 2007 the Troutdale City Council adopted Resolution No. 1901 that authorized an application to the State of Oregon for establishment of a joint Enterprise Zone with the City of Fairview. The Oregon Community and Economic Development Department (OECDD) approved the City's application and the Columbia Cascade Enterprise Zone has been designated.
2. Resolution 1901 specifically appointed John Anderson, Troutdale's City Administrator at that time, as Enterprise Zone co-manager along with an official appointed by the City of Fairview.
3. John Anderson retired from employment with the City of Troutdale in October 2008 and no longer serves as Enterprise Zone co-manager.
4. The OECDD has asked that the City of Troutdale appoint another co-manager in place of John Anderson.
5. Appointing a co-manager by job title with the City of Troutdale rather than by name will avoid the need for future corrections whenever there is a personnel change.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The City Administrator, or the Administrator's designee, is appointed to serve as Troutdale's manager of the Columbia Cascade Enterprise Zone and will serve as a co-manager with Fairview's appointed manager.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
