

## **RESOLUTION NO. 1987**

### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE PORT OF PORTLAND AND OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE I-84 FRONTAGE ROAD RIGHT-TURN-LANE PROJECT**

#### **THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Oregon Department of Transportation intends to undertake a project on South Frontage Road to separate the eastbound combined through/right-turn lane into a dedicated through lane and separate dedicated right-turn lane.
2. The City of Troutdale, ODOT and the Port of Portland signed a Memorandum of Understanding dated September 27, 2007 regarding the parties' intention to participate jointly in the project.
3. Based on the good-faith intentions expressed in the MOU, ODOT has proceeded with and completed design of the project. ODOT is now prepared to advertise and award the project.
4. Per the MOU, the Parties are to execute a Cooperative Improvement Agreement binding the previous commitments prior to award of the contract.
5. The agreement has been prepared and is attached herewith.

#### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE**

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement between the City, Port of Portland and Oregon Department of Transportation, substantially as attached herewith in Attachment A.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
