

RESOLUTION NO. 2056

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TRANSFERRING THE SURPLUS PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF GRESHAM.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Troutdale Police Department has two vehicles, a 1999 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W3XX152342 and a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W9YX169566 which are no longer in service and which, because of their age, mileage, and use in service are of minimal value on the open market.
2. The transfer of the vehicles, to the City of Gresham for use by its Police Department, shall be for the express purpose of training officers in Emergency Vehicle Operations (EVO).
3. The City of Troutdale has provisions contained in TMC 2.52 outlining the methods and procedures for the disposal of surplus property.
4. The City of Troutdale has such surplus property available to be transferred to the City of Gresham for the purpose of training officers in Emergency Vehicle Operations (EVO).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

- Section 1. The vehicles: a 1999 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W3XX152342 and a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W9YX169566 are declared to be surplus.
- Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to execute the Surplus Equipment Donation Agreement substantially in accordance with Agreement attached as an Exhibit to the staff report.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.

City of Troutdale
Surplus Equipment Donation Agreement

This Agreement is made and entered into by the City of Troutdale, an Oregon Municipal Corporation, and the City of Gresham, an Oregon Municipal Corporation. The purpose of this agreement is to provide for the donation of a 1999 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W3XX152342 and a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W9YX169566 (hereinafter "vehicles"), by the City of Troutdale to the City of Gresham for use by its Police Department.

Recitals

WHEREAS, City of Troutdale's Police Department has two vehicles, a 1999 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W3XX152342 and a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W9YX169566 which are no longer in service and which, because of their age, mileage, and use in service, have been declared to be surplus property and are of minimal value on the open market; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gresham Police Department can make use of these vehicles for the purpose of Emergency Vehicle Operation (EVO) training; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gresham has requested that the City of Troutdale donate the two vehicles to it for that purpose.

The parties agree as follows:

1. The City of Troutdale agrees to donate the 1999 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W3XX152342 and the 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W9YX169566 in their present "as-is" condition to the City of Gresham to be used for the purpose of Emergency Vehicle Operation (EVO) training.
2. The City of Gresham assumes all responsibility and liability for said vehicles from the time that they take possession of the "said vehicles" and are solely responsible for the removal and transportation of the 1999 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W3XX152342 and the 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W9YX169566.
3. The City of Troutdale will transfer title of the vehicles to the City of Gresham, after which the City of Troutdale's insurance coverage shall no longer apply to the vehicles. The City of Troutdale shall thereafter have no responsibility for the vehicles, and the City of Gresham expressly acknowledges that the City of Troutdale, its officers, agents, employees and insurance carrier, shall have no responsibility for the vehicles after title is transferred.
4. All markings and decals identifying the 1999 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W3XX152342 and the 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W9YX169566 as the City of Troutdale's property

shall be removed by the City of Gresham after taking possession of the vehicles, at Gresham's expense.

5. The City of Gresham, its Officers, agents, and employees, understand and agree that the terms and conditions of this donation agreement require title to the vehicles be transferred to the City of Gresham and that the provisions of paragraph 4 herein are complied with before the City of Gresham is authorized to use the vehicles.
