

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2078**

### **A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE GLENN OTTO PARK TRANSIT STOP IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF AN ODOT FLEXIBLE FUNDS PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION**

#### **THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. TriMet has been using Troutdale's Glenn Otto Park as a transit bus stop on a trial basis to evaluate performance compatibility and to determine whether it can operate safely within this heavily used park.
2. During this trial period it has been demonstrated that this extended bus route to the park and use of the park as a stop and turnaround point can operate safely and coexist with other uses of the park.
3. The land use permit to establish the bus route within the park stipulated that a number of site improvements are needed before it can remain there permanently. The required upgrades to the site must be made or else use of the park for a bus stop is out of compliance with the land use permit and will have to be moved elsewhere.
4. The most significant improvement necessary for the continued use of this site for the bus route terminous and turnaround is paving the existing gravel circulation drive and bus parking pad and adding a concrete walkway for riders to use as a boarding pad.
5. The City desires to have permanent transit service to Glenn Otto Park and supports constructing the necessary improvements within the park to make this possible.
6. ODOT's Flexible Funds Program provides grants to fund transit related projects.


#### **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE**
