

RESOLUTION NO. 2130

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TRANSFERRING THE SURPLUS PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF SANDY.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Troutdale Police Department has a vehicle, a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN# 2FAFP71W7YX169565 which is no longer in service and, because of its age, mileage, and use in service is of minimal value on the open market.
2. The City of Troutdale Police Department has an inventory of ICOP in-car video equipment which, due to its age, is no longer in service and is obsolete.
3. The City of Sandy can put the vehicle to use for the purpose of prisoner transport and can put the inventory of ICOP in-car video equipment to use for replacement parts.
4. The City of Troutdale has provisions contained in TMC 2.52 outlining the methods and procedures for the disposal of surplus property.
5. The City of Troutdale has such surplus property available to be transferred to the City of Sandy for the purpose of prisoner transport and ICOP parts replacement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

- Section 1. The vehicle: a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN# 2FAFP71W7YX169565 and the inventory of ICOP in-car video equipment consisting of units SN# D0660005, D0660006 and D0590180 are declared to be surplus.
- Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to execute the Surplus Equipment Donation Agreement substantially in accordance with Agreement attached as an Exhibit to the staff report.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.

City of Troutdale
Surplus Equipment Donation Agreement

This Agreement is made and entered into by the City of Troutdale, an Oregon Municipal Corporation, and the City of Sandy, an Oregon Municipal Corporation. The purpose of this agreement is to provide for the donation of a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W7YX169565 (hereinafter "vehicle") and an inventory of ICOP in-car video equipment consisting of units SN #D0660005, D0660006 and D0590180 (hereinafter "ICOP"), by the City of Troutdale to the City of Sandy for use by its Police Department.

Recitals

WHEREAS, City of Troutdale's Police Department has a vehicle, a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W7YX169565 which, because of its age, mileage, and use in service, has been declared to be surplus property and is of minimal value on the open market; together with the ICOP in-car video equipment which, due to its age, is no longer in service and is obsolete; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy Police Department can make use of this vehicle for the purpose of prisoner transport and can make use of the ICOP equipment for the purpose of replacement parts for their ICOP system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sandy has requested that the City of Troutdale donate the vehicle and equipment to it for that purpose.

The parties agree as follows:

1. The City of Troutdale agrees to donate the 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN# 2FAFP71W7YX169565 in its "as-is" condition to the City of Sandy to be used for the purpose of prisoner transport.
2. The City of Troutdale agrees to donate the ICOP in-car video equipment in its "as-is" condition to the City of Sandy to be used for the purpose of replacement parts.
3. The City of Sandy is solely responsible for the removal and transportation of the 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W7YX169565 and the ICOP equipment.
4. The City of Troutdale will transfer title of the vehicle to the City of Sandy, after which the City of Troutdale's insurance coverage shall no longer apply to the vehicle. The City of Troutdale shall thereafter have no responsibility for the vehicle or ICOP equipment, and the City of Sandy expressly acknowledges that the City of Troutdale, its officers, agents, employees and insurance carrier, shall have no responsibility for the vehicle or ICOP equipment after title is transferred.

5. All markings and decals identifying the 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W7YX169565 as the City of Troutdale's property shall be removed by the City of Sandy after taking possession of the vehicle, at Sandy's expense.
6. The City of Sandy, it's Officers, agents, and employees understand and agree that the terms and conditions of this donation agreement require that title to the vehicle be transferred to the City of Sandy and, additionally, that the provisions of paragraph 4 herein are complied with before the City of Sandy is authorized to use the vehicles.
7. The City of Sandy agrees to provide the City of Troutdale Police Department the use of their firearms range, free of cost, for the next four years following the signing of this agreement.
