

RESOLUTION NO. 2227

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2214 ADOPTING THE SANITARY SEWER MASTER PLAN DATED MAY 2013

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. On May 29, 2013, the Planning Commission voted to recommend that the Public Facilities Plan (PFP), of which the Sanitary Sewer Master Plan is a component, be forwarded to the City Council for adoption. Subsequent to review of the PFP by the Planning Commission, the list of recommended projects in the Sanitary Sewer Master Plan was updated to add one additional proposed project: a pump, control and wet well improvement project at Pump Station #2.
2. Council adopted the Sanitary Sewer Master Plan, dated May 2013, by Resolution No. 2214 on June 11, 2013. At the June 25, 2013 meeting, in accordance with council rules and procedures, the Council voted to reconsider said resolution at the July 9, 2013 meeting. Council considered the matter on July 9th and directed staff to prepare a resolution rescinding Resolution No. 2214.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. Resolution No. 2214, which adopted the Sanitary Sewer Master Plan, is rescinded.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective upon adoption.


