

RESOLUTION NO. 2283

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE HALSEY CORRIDOR METRO GRANT APPLICATION

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Halsey Street from the Sandy River area, west to 207th Street, links three cities, including Troutdale, but has not been subject to a thorough economic and development analysis to identify opportunities and plan for them.
2. The cities of Troutdale, Wood Village, and Fairview, wish to combine resources and obtain additional funding, to obtain professional services which may produce an economic development plan along an important transportation corridor.
3. The staff members of these three cities wish to approach their Councils, present a letter of intent to seek Metro Cycle 4 grant money, and request official consideration and endorsement of this effort.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The City Manager shall collaborate with professional staff of Fairview and Wood Village, and other necessary persons, to apply for a Metro Cycle 4 grant, and produce an economic development plan for the Halsey Corridor.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to share, with the cities of Wood Village and Fairview, combined matching funds totaling up to \$30,000 in cash or in-kind contributions, in proportions to be developed and agreed upon by the professional staff of those cities.
