

RESOLUTION NO. 2389

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MULTNOMAH COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the protection of citizens and property within the corporate limits of the City of Troutdale there needs to be a plan which determines how the city and surrounding jurisdictions respond and coordinate efforts in the event of a natural disaster.
2. Over the last 4 years the City, the Cities of Gresham, Fairview and Wood Village, along with Multnomah County, have cooperated to create a Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan that would meet all of their needs for a plan.
3. The process of updating the City's Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan is now complete and has been approved by both the State and Federal agencies overseeing the creation of Natural Hazard Mitigation Plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE


Section 1. The City council hereby adopts the Multnomah County Multijurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan.
