

RESOLUTION NO. 2011

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE COMPLETION OF THE PARKS & FACILITIES HEADQUARTERS AND ACCEPTING IT INTO THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET SYSTEM.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The construction of the Parks & Facilities headquarters was necessary to meet the demands of public health, safety, and welfare.
2. The construction of the Parks & Facilities headquarters has been completed and inspected by City staff and by the City's consulting engineer, Group Mackenzie.
3. The construction of the Parks & Facilities headquarters has been found to be in substantial compliance with the plans and specifications for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE


Section 1. The following capital improvements associated with the Parks & Facilities headquarters are accepted into the City's fixed asset system, valued as follows:



Shop Building	203,000
Sanitary sewer extension, consisting of 173 linear feet of 8" PVC sewer main and one 48" manhole as shown on Sheet U2.1 of the project as-builts.	17,205
Total Estimated Value:	\$1,274,464

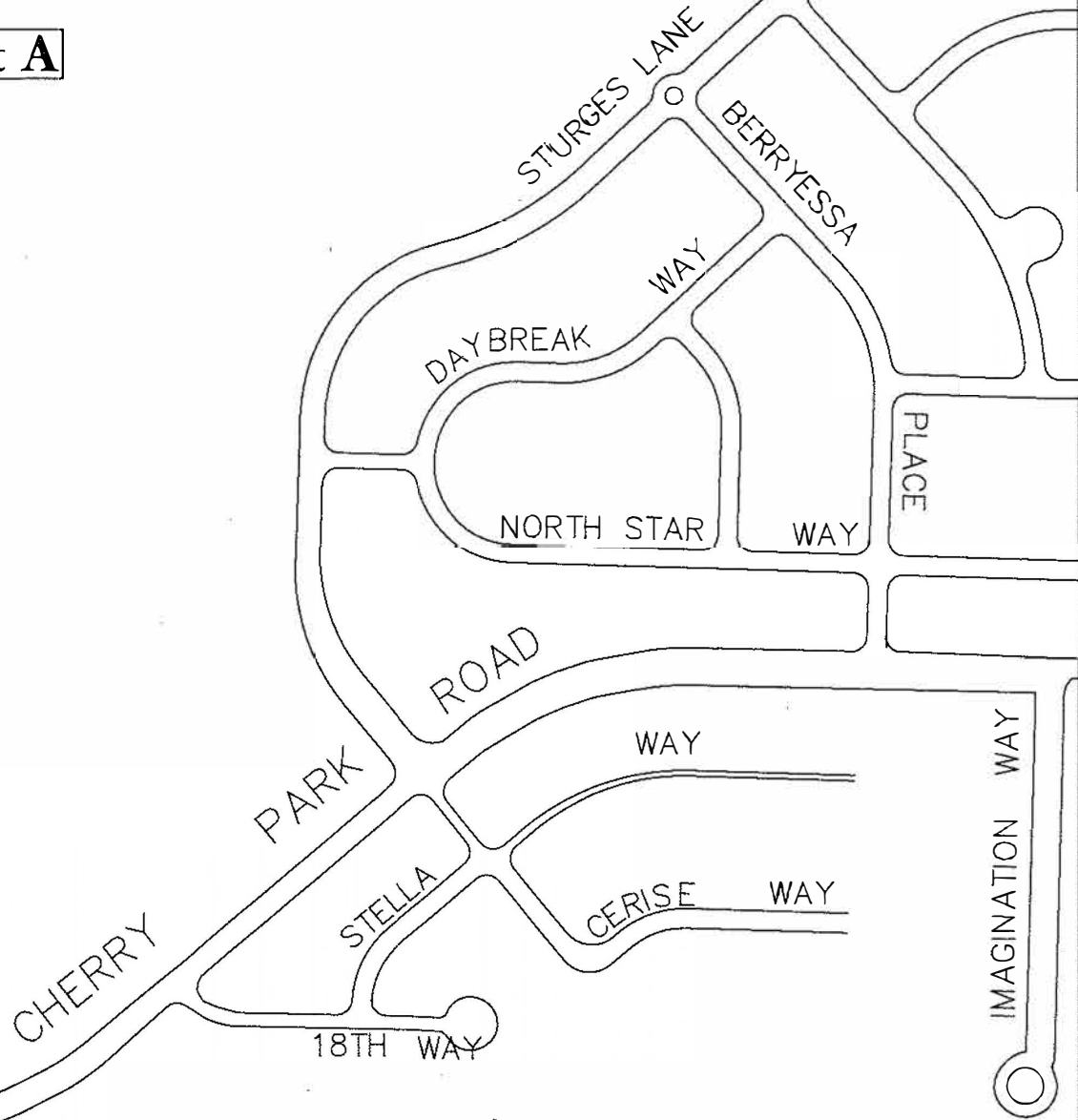
