

RESOLUTION NO. 2061

A RESOLUTION AMENDING ATTACHMENT "A" TO RESOLUTION NO. 1772 LISTING CITY BUILDING FEE EXEMPTIONS AND REDUCTIONS FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC SERVICE AND NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:


1. Resolution No. 1772, adopted on June 28, 2005, adopted city building rental fee exemptions and reductions for certain public service and non-profit organizations that had historically received rental fee exemptions and reductions. These certain organizations were listed in Attachment A to the resolution.
2. Resolution No. 1772 authorized the Director of Community Development to grant a waiver or fee reduction for local public service and non-profit organizations not listed on Attachment A if the Director determined an organization met specific criteria spelled out in the resolution. If the Director made such a determination, then Attachment A was to be updated accordingly.
3. The Director of Community Development recently learned that the Larch Mt. Country Artisans, a local non-profit organization, has been paying a reduced fee for rental of the Sam Cox Building for its annual Heart of the Country artisans show for a number of years but that Attachment A to Resolution No. 1772 has not been revised to reflect this.
4. Rental fee increases adopted in March 2010 should not apply to the Larch Mt. Country Artisans' annual arts and crafts show held in the Sam Cox Building because they meet the criteria for reduced fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:


- Section 1. Attachment A to Resolution No. 1772 is amended to read as shown on Attachment A to this resolution.
- Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

BUILDING RENTAL FEE EXEMPTIONS AND REDUCTIONS

The following organizations shall pay no fee to use city buildings for meetings or other events:

- Historical Society (City Hall)
- Booster Club (fundraisers for lifeguards)
- Chamber of Commerce
- Downtown Merchants Association
- Troutdale Brownies
- Friends of Beaver Creek
- Oregon State Police Volunteers
- Reynolds School District (we use their space for Recreation Programs)
- Troutdale Boy Scout Troop
- Troutdale Cub Scout Troop
- NW Steelheaders (perform volunteer work to use the building)
- Lions Club
- Fairview/Troutdale Masonic Lodge (use ovens only)
- American Medical Response (training for lifeguards)
- Non-local scout groups
- Red Cross (blood drives)

The following organizations shall pay \$10 per meeting to use city buildings:

- Poets of Light (Troutdale Photography Club)
- Reynolds Girls Softball Association
- Reynolds Little League
- Rockwood/Reynolds Soccer Club
- Local AA Group

The following organization shall pay \$40 per meeting to use city buildings:

- NW Fly Fishers

The following organization shall pay \$150 to rent the Sam Cox Building for a full day:

- Gresham Shriners Club

The following organization shall pay \$850 to rent the Sam Cox Building great room and annex for three full days in conjunction with its annual artisan's show and sale:

- Larch Mountain Country Artisans
