

RESOLUTION NO. 2085

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TROUTDALE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Troutdale Hazard Mitigation Plan was developed in part with a FEMA Flood Mitigation Assistance Planning grant to Multnomah County for the development of flood hazard mitigation plans for Troutdale, Fairview and Wood Village. The Hazard Mitigation Plan for the City of Troutdale covers each of the major natural hazards that pose risks to the City.
2. The primary objectives of this Mitigation plan are to reduce the negative impacts of future disasters on the community: to save lives and reduce injuries, minimize damage to buildings and infrastructure (especially critical facilities) and minimize economic losses.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The City of Troutdale Hazard Mitigation Plan dated December 14, 2010, which is attached to the Staff report as exhibit "A", is hereby adopted.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
