

RESOLUTION NO. 2112

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY OF TROUTDALE'S ELECTION TO RECEIVE STATE SHARED REVENUES FOR FY 2011-2012.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. A share of certain revenues of the State of Oregon are apportioned among and distributed to the cities in the state for general purposes.
2. A city must elect to receive distributions under ORS 221.770 for the fiscal year by enactment of a resolution expressing that election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1 Pursuant to ORS 221.770, the City hereby elects to receive state revenues for fiscal year 2011-2012.

Section 2. That the City of Troutdale hereby certifies that a public hearing before the Budget Committee of the City of Troutdale was held on April 18, 2011 giving citizens an opportunity to comment on the possible uses of State Revenue Sharing.

Section 3. That the City of Troutdale hereby certifies that a public hearing before the City Council was held on June 14, 2011 giving citizens an opportunity to comment on the proposed uses of State Revenue Sharing.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
