

RESOLUTION NO. 2119

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THREE HUNDRED 2007 TROUTDALE CENTENNIAL POSTERS AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Troutdale purchased 500 Centennial Posters for our 100 Year Anniversary. Proceeds from the sale of the posters went towards the cost of the Centennial Arch Monument.
2. The 100 Year Celebration took place on October 6, 2007. Poster sales declined a few months after the event. Attempts were made to sell additional posters at other city events during 2008. The Posters have continued to be available at City Hall, although there have been very few purchased.
3. In the July/August 2011 edition of the Troutdale Champion Newsletter we advertised a "sale" on the posters reducing the purchase price from \$25 to \$5 each with the sale ending on July 31st. We sold 27 posters during the month of July 2011.
4. Section 2.52.060 of the Troutdale Municipal Code relating to surplus personal property allows for the City Manager, or designee, to sell personal property that has been declared as surplus by the Council to the highest competitive bidder.
5. As of the date this resolution was prepared we have 340 posters remaining. The City would like to keep approximately 40 posters in stock to give away as gifts and dispose of the remaining 300 posters to the highest bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. Three Hundred 2007 Centennial Posters are hereby declared surplus property.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to sell the remaining Centennial Posters to the highest bidder as authorized in 2.52.060 of the Troutdale Municipal Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
