Public Art Committee Meeting Feb.21, 2013 11:00 am

The meeting was convened at 11:00 a.m. Members present were Sandy Bonney, Chair, Loree Pryce PWDS Director, Destiny Scwartz, Lea Ray, and Jan Richey. The minutes of January 17, 2013 were approved.

## REGULAR AGENDA

A. Fire Hydrant painting: Loree brought up that the bonnets of the hydrants need to be of a regulated color to indicate water pressure to the fire department. She agreed to find out the needed color for the three hydrants proposed for the dog park. Three hydrants will be made available for painting this month and Sandy proposed they should be Dalmatians. Loree and committee members will inventory and collect acrylic brushes and paint. A wire brush, primer, sealer and a Sharpie marker will also be needed. Good luck with these. I can t wait to see them.

B. Murals: After discussion, the committee decided that a realistic goal would be to renovate the wall of the pool enclosure, to design and paint the wall of the ramp at the skate park and to repaint the low wall on Chetco. Loree agreed to investigate liability insurance for these projects and project V/A below.

C. It was decided to submit a request for \$7,500 as a budget and to investigate writing grants for additional funds.

D. There was no information regarding aerial photos for the board room. Sandy offered to contact Ross at the Pilot.

## INFORMATION/UPDATES

A. Carpenterville Sign: Jan reported that the sign is mounted on steel posts and the background is grey wood, probably Port Orford Cedar, which is unpainted and would not require paint. The letters are raised as is the seagull, and could easily be repainted. A letter for the mayor to review and present to the city council to be sent to South Coast Lumber was discussed.

B. Wording for an ad in the Pilot: After the insurance matter is settled, and when the murals are ready for paint, the wording for the ad will ask for volunteers to take on these tasks. The ads will likely require City Council approval. The parameters for these projects are ongoing, but development of the ad and the murals will be top priority items for future meetings.

C. Artists: Sandy is on the PBAA board and agreed to take our minutes to their board meeting and request their support.
