




Murals 1 through 5 sponsored and funded by the Cottage Grove Mural Committee



1920's Main Street Scene Mural - This 12' x 73' mural is on the west wall of 501 East Main Street, currently operating as Shoestrings. The mural is an authentic rendering of Main Street, Cottage Grove in the 1920's, as recorded in a photo from the period. Artist: Connie Huston. 2007



Welcome To Cottage Grove Mural - This mural is painted on the east and south walls of the Moose Lodge, located at 711 Highway 99S (Near the intersection of Highway 99 and Harrison Street). Artist: Suzi Marquess Long. 2004



Fourth of July Parade Scene Mural - This 14' x 90' mural is painted on the south wall of 119 South 6th Street, currently operating as The Flower Basket & Gift Boutique. The mural is a rendering of a Fourth of July Parade scene, utilizing photos taken on Main Street, Cottage Grove in the early 1900's. Artist: Howard Tharpe. 2005



Buster Keaton Mural - This mural is painted on the east wall of the building adjacent to the old Cottage Grove Hotel, which is located at the intersection of Highway 99 and Main Street. The mural commemorates the motion picture, "The General," which was filmed near Cottage Grove in 1926. Artist: Howard Tharpe. 2002



Opal Whiteley Mural - This mural is painted on the east wall of 711 East Main Street building, currently operating as Rainy Peak Cyclery. The Mural overlooks the "All America City" Square Park at the intersection of 7th and Main, and commemorates former resident and author Opal Whiteley (1897-1992).
