SPECIAL MEETING

JUNE 22, 1987

MINUTES FOR APPROVAL

By a unanimous vote (motion: Commissioner Brimm, second: Commissioner Hagen), the Planning Commission approved the minutes of the Commission meeting of June 2, 1987.

THE PLANNING COMMISSION TOOK THE FOLLOWING ACTION

1. By a unanimous vote (motion: Commissioner Hagen, second: Commissioner Brimm), the Commission accepted the Planning Staff Agenda Report, dated June 11, 1987, and granted a request for a conditional use permit to allow for the use of a structure as a public utility facility storage building within the confines of the Coos-Curry Electric Cooperative, Inc., storage yard in order to enclose equipment presently being stored outside. Subject property generally located on the southeast corner of Chetco Avenue (Highway 101) and Mill Beach Road (identified as Tax Lot 200, Assessor's Parcel Map No. 41-13-6D) within the Commercial General (C-G) zoning district (File No. CUP-2-87); Coos-Curry Electric Cooperative, Inc., applicant.

This action was taken following closure of the public hearing at which the following person spoke in favor of the request:

(a) Lauren Porsch, 915 Chetco Avenue, representing the applicant.

The Commission further directed staff to present a final ORDER and Findings of Fact document for consideration for action by the Commission later on the agenda.
