MESSAGES AND PAPERS FROM THE CITY MANAGER

- 1. The City Manager requested comments, suggestions and recommendations from the Commission regarding a request from the Brook-Haven Home Trust for the City to pave and maintain a pathway located along the northerly boundary of the Brook-Haven PUD. This pathway is located mostly on City owned land and a small portion of land belonging to the Trust. The Trust has offered to dedicate its portion of the pathway to the City asking in return that the City maintain the pathway. Richard Calkins, Chairman of the Brook-Haven Trust presented the proposal. After discussion the Commission passed by unanimous vote (motion: Commissioner Ham; second: Commissioner Breuer) to send a positive recommendation to the City Council to accept transfer of ownership on the remaining part of the pathway and to pave it.
- 2. In the matter of two small parcels of land that the City owns on the west side of Cove Road and on the west side of Memory Lane the City Manager requested comments and opinions as to whether the City should sell these lots.

By unaminous vote (motion: Commissioner Freeman; second: Commissioner Lindsey) the Commission will send a recommendation to the Council to liquidate these properties.

PROPOSITIONS AND REMARKS FROM COMMISSION MEMBERS

Commissioner Breuer requested information on the status of 828 Railroad. The Planning Director reported that this is being worked on.

Chair Ciapusci asked for clarification on the County's stand on applications within the UGB. He reminded all Commission members of next Tuesday's joint meeting between the City Council and the Planning Commission.
