By a 4-0 vote (motion: Commissioner Lindsey, second: Commissioner Dentino, Ex Officio Commissioner Ball gave an affirmative advisory-only vote; Commissioner Freeman declared bias and removed himself from the bench. Commissioner Breuer accepted the gavel and conducted the hearing) the Planning Commission approved (File No. M3-5-98-98) a request for a minor partition to divide a 0.71 acre parent parcel into two lots of 15,094 and 15,819 sq. ft.; located on the north side of Easy Street approximately 230 feet east of Fourth Street; zoned R-1-6 (Single-family Residential, 6,000 sq. ft. minimum lot size); P. John Kim, applicant; Lloyd Matlock, representative. The approval was granted with an additional condition:

The applicant shall present engineered drainage plans to be reviewed and approved by the City Engineer. These plans shall address the existing drainage system across the subject property and the ability of the drainage on the south side of Easy Street to accommodate additional runoff generated by development on the subject property.
