

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY  
PLANNING COMMISSION, July 7, 1953

Meeting: called to order at 8:15 by chairman Young.

Members present: O.D. Arp, Ed Aldrich, Roy Weideman and James Yelton.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

Reports of Committees:

Mr. Arp reported that the McClain petition had now been complied with as to requirements of Ordinance #35 and thereby referred to the City Planning Commission for action.

After checking this petition for sufficiency and compliance, the Commission ~~was~~ prepared to be submitted to the City Council, the following tentative report:

The City Planning Commission of the City of Brookings at it's regular meeting on July 7th, 1953, has checked the petition of Ed. F. McClain and Alf Larson for a proposed change in the use of lots 1 & 2, block 3, Coastwise subdivision and herewith report the same as sufficient and in compliance with Ordinance #35 and has set July 13th. 1953 at 8 P.M. for public hearing.

Motion was made by Mr. Aldrich seconded by Mr. Weideman that we recommend to the Council that six "Traffic Laws Strictly Enforced" and two "Stop for Pedestrians" signs be purchased. Carried.

New Business:

A letter from the Balsiger Motor Company asking the permission of the Planning Commission to install a used car lot between Young's Motel and the bank for a 4 month period, read. Motion was made by Mr. Yelton, seconded by Mr. Weideman that the Planning Commission favor the application of the Balsiger Motor Company for a temporary permit for this car lot. Carried.
