BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON:

That at the initiative of the Council and on its own motion all and entire of the following described peal property, lying within the City of Brookings, Oregon, be zoned as and under the designation of C-2 Central Commercial District, as the same is set forth and defined in Ordinance No. 19, of the City of Brookings, and that such of the said real property as lies and is contained within a zone, defined and designated in said Ordinance as C-1 Tourist Commercial District be rezoned as aforesaid C-2 Central Commercial District.

The hereinabove set forth, and referred to real property is more fully described as follows: A tract of land lying in the Southeast Quarter (SET) of the Northwest Quarter (NET) of Section Six (6), Township Forty-one (41) South, Range Thirteen (13) West of Willamette Meridian, Curry County, Oregon; beginning at a point on the East-West center line of said Section Six (6), said point being East 565.80 feet from the Southwest corner of the said SET of NET and also West 754.80 feet from the center of said Section Six (6); thence East 407.10 feet; thence North 16 deg. 38 min. East 145.70 feet to a point on the Westerly line of U. S. Highway 101; thence following said highway line Northwesterly (North 73 deg. 32 min. West) 496.00 feet, more or less, to a point which bears North 5 deg. 11 min. West from the point of beginning: thence South 5 deg. 11 min. East 286.30 feet to the point of beginning.

That upon the adoption of this Resolution the City Recorder of Brookings shall immediately give notice to the Planning Commission of the City of Brookings of said passage and shall at the same time transmit to the said Commission a duly certified copy of this resolution.

That the said Planning Commission shall within ten (10) days after it has received said notice from the City Recorder make its tentative report and hold such public meeting thereon at such times as the said Planning Commission may, at its discretion, deem necessary.

That, within five (5) days after the expiration of the aforesaid ten (10) days period of time, the final report of the Planning Commission upon the aforesaid proposed change, alteration and amendment of the zoning of the aforesaid described real property shall be filed by the said Commission with the City Recorder.
