

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY PLANNING COMMISSION, 9/7/54

Meeting called to order by chairman Luther Tisdale.

Present: Messrs. Aldrich, Arp, Osborn, Tygart, Weideman & Yelton.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved with the correction that size of maps read fourtimes present size instead of twice.

Reports of Committees:

Mr. Yelton reported that he had made no contacts in regard to the Hart-Stotenberg truck terminal site because he was under the impression that Richfield had decided to put in such a terminal.

Secretary reported that the council without taking any particular action, had pointed out that the newly paved Hillside and Pacific Avenues had been paved expressly so that it would bear heavy traffic.

New Business:

A petition by L.E. Lessard to re-zone a certain piece of property referred by the City Council to the Planning Commission was presented and read by the secy. Mr. Arp explained the petition in detail.

No action being possible until a hearing on the petition was held, the secretary was instructed to publish a notice of hearing in the Sept. 23rd. issue of the Brookings-Harbor Pilot, to be held Oct. 5th. and to so advise the City Council.

Mr. Arp reported that signs would be erected on Spruce St. with minimum weight of 6000 lbs.

Motion was made by Mr. Tygart, second by Mr. Tisdale that the Commission adjourn until Oct. 5th. 1954.
