The plans of the Mid Oil Service Station to build a station on the corner of Arnold Lane and U.S. Highway #101 was presented in tentative form by Mr. Reed. Permit was approved subject to the building and zoning ordinances. Motion was made by Mr. Loring seconded by Mr. Goetz to this effect and recommended that a flat reef be used. Motion carried.
