

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

4/16/57

Meeting called to order by chairman, Roy Weideman.

Members present: Messrs. Bullock, Goetz, Loring, Stanhurst and Weideman. Others: Chas. Echols.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

Mr. Goetz reported being present at the last Council meeting when the Planning Commission 's letter in regard to re-zoning the Chetco Riverfront into a commercial zone, was read. He the City Council would have to wait a period of sixty days if the Planning Commission refuses to approve. The Mayor stated that he would see Mr. Bankus for a public easement.

Mr. Weideman warned against the danger of allowing a State weighing station in the center of town. Such a station would tie up logging trucks in the center of town obstructing traffic.

No report was received from the City Council regarding the clean-up ordinance suggestion.

No report was received from the City Engineer, Mr. Martin regarding paving standards, nor easement resolution

No report received from the City Council regarding our county court recommendation for a county planning commission nor no answer to our letter regarding the Council's Resolution #29.

The secretary was asked to write the City Council that when new appointments are made for vacancies on the Planning Commission that the name of Archie McVay be given favorable consideration.

Motion was made by Mr. Loring, seconded by Mr. Goetz that the secretary's bill for services including May 7th. in the sum of \$35.00 be approved. Motion carried.
