

The SPECIAL MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION  
July 16, 1957

Meeting called to order by Chairman, Gordon Goetz.

Members Present: Messrs. Goetz, Gulley, Hysom, Loring, McVay and Stanhurst. Others present were Chas. Echols and Willard Spencer.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

Secretary reported sending letter to City Attorney, Mr. Balderee in Re: proper procedure to allow Mr. Hysom's request for a permit to install a 50-unit mobile homes project on a location on Arnold Lane and U. S. Highway #101.

Re-modeling of old Leonard house discussed. The secretary was asked to find out if a building permit had been issued by Mrs. Redfield or anyone to do this re-modeling.

The secretary was asked to check with the City Recorder to find out how much remained in the budget of the Planning Commission for the fiscal year just ending. Motion was made by Mr. Stanhurst, seconded by Mr. Hysom that the secy's services be paid for June and July inclusive in the sum of \$25.00 be allowed. Unan. carried.

Upon the invitation of Mayor Campbell, the Commission adjourned to the Council chambers to hear Mr. Ayers of the State Highway Department discuss aid for our street problems. Mr. Ayers said only the per capita annual funds given regularly each year to the street fund, would be available this year, approximately \$11,000. He added that no aid from the state for street surfacing would be possible this year.
