Members present were Messrs Goetz, Bullock, McVay, Molina, Loring,

Mr./Townsend, replacing Mr. Gulley, was cordially welcomed
into the membership by Chairman Goetz and other members.

The Commission was asked to approve the abandonment of the
easements on Fifth Street from U.S. Highway #101 to Easy St.
between the Zigler, Kemp, Woodard, George and Bankus properties.
Motion was made by Mr. Loring, seconded by Mr. Stanhurst
approving such abandonment. Unan. passed.

Mr. Goetz reminded the group of the League of Oregon Cities
Meeting on November 16, 17, and 18th. at Eugene, and urged
attendance by members. A letter requesting suggestions for
discussion topics was read and the following were approved.

1. Water Supply
2. Street surfacing
3. Highway by-pass or alternate route
4. Traffic congestion.

Mr. Stanhurst signified his intention of attending this
meeting.

A duplication of recommendations to council was found to be
a typographical error and the City Council was so advised.

On motion meeting adjourned.

Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge your letter of November 1, 1958, calling our attention to an error in our recommendations to the Council.

It was and is the intention and purpose of the Planning Commission to re-zone Lots 73 to 82 inclusive of the Thornton and Ward Tract located near the new school site on Easy Street, from an Agricultural to an R-3. If our recommendations show differently, they are in error and were inadvertently typed in error. We appreciate your calling this matter to our attention.

Recommendation #49 should request the following zone changes:

Tax Lot 22, 21, 21A, 20, 19, 24J, 24 K, 24 and 24G
Section 31, up-zoned from Agricultural to R-1 and,

Lot 6B, 6, 6A, 7A, 7, 7D, 7B, 7C, 5C, 5A, 5B, 5, and 21B,
21, 21A, 22, 23A, Section 5, up-zoned from Agricultural to R-2 and

Tax Lot 66, 66A-1, 66 A-2, 66A-3, 66A-4, 66A-5, 66A,
tax lot 67, 68, 69, 69A, 70, 71, 71A, 72, 92, 91, 90, 89, 89
A, 88, 87, 86, 85, 84, 83, a portion bound on the West
by 6th street, on the North by Ransome Ave. on the East
by 7th St. and on the South by Easy Street, a portion of
M-1 and lot 30F-1, up-zoned from Agricultural to R-3 all
in Section 6.
