

Minutes of the Special Meeting of the City Planning Commission  
Feb. 18, 1958

Meeting called to order by Chairman, Gordon Goetz.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

The Secretary reported that City Atty. Mr. Balderree had answered our letter requesting his attendance at this meeting of the Planning Commission, but that he would be out of town for a brief Southern vacation and would be unable to attend and to please accept his apologies.

Mr. Stanhurst reported that he had contacted the Brown's, who have five acres just off Ransome Avenue, in regard to a trailer site, and that they were considering the matter.

Mr. Strobel asked about water and sewer possibilities in this area.

Mrs. Kanick reported that she had been unable to get access to old records except in the presence of the City Recorder and therefore had no files or city ordinances accessible to the members of the planning commission. She reported that to date she had been unable to get the proper wording for re-zoning petition and street vacation petition.
