

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the City Planning Commission
March 4, 1958

Meeting called to order by chairman, Gordon Goetz.

Members present: Messrs. Bullock, Goetz, Gulley, Loring and Stanhurst. Guest present, Ira Brown.

Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

Mr. Goetz reported attending the last council meeting and that Mayor Campbell had offered to get City Atty. Mr. Balderee to stay over next council meeting for a meeting with the Planning Commission.

Mr. Goetz presented a set of City Ordinances loaned him by Pop Reed. He suggested we get one of our for our Planning Commission files.

Gladys Kanick reported that petitions for the re-zoning of the school board's site on Easy Street and for the vacation of 7th street, were being circulated for signatures.

Mr. Brown was present to find out how to get his property re-zoned into a C-1, in order to put in a trailer court.

The zoning ordinance was read by the secretary. The need for someone to check petitions for sufficiency was discussed.

It was decided that the members of the commission meet with the City Council at it's next meeting and ask Mr. Balderree questions regarding the re-zoning of school property, the vacation of 7th St. and Mr. Brown's re-zoning project.
