

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

HELD MAY 5, 1959

THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION MET IN REGULAR SESSION ON MAY 5, 1959,
AT 8:00 P.M.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN ROBERT STANHURST. PRESENT
WERE CHAIRMAN STANHURST, MESSRS. MOLINO, LORING, TOWNSEND, DEMPSEY, ECHOLS,
MAYOR CAMPBELL, AMES AND OTHERS.

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING HELD ON APRIL 7, 1959, WERE READ AND
APPROVED.

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON APRIL 14, 1959, WERE
READ.

A PETITION SIGNED BY TWENTY INDIVIDUALS REQUESTING THAT ACTION BE TAKEN
TO REZONE LOT NO. 19-A FROM R-1 TO C-1 WAS PRESENTED, AND READ. A MOTION
WAS MADE BY MR. LORING AND SECONDED BY MR. TOWNSEND RECOMMENDATION BE
GIVEN THE CITY COUNCIL TO REZONE THIS PROPERTY. MOTION CARRIED.

CHIEF CROSS REQUESTED THE COMMISSION'S APPROVAL TO CHANGE THE ONE-WAY
STREET NEAR THE SHELL SERVICE STATION TO A TWO-WAY STREET AND THAT A
STOP SIGN BE INSTALLED AT THE REAR OF THE SHELL STATION ON FERN STREET.
A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. MOLINO AND SECONDED BY MR. LORING THAT CHIEF
CROSS BE AUTHORIZED TO RECOMMEND TO THE COUNCIL THAT THE STREET CHANGE
BE MADE. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

INSTALLATION OF A STREET LIGHT NEAR O'HALLERANS AND MORRIS-KNUDSON'S
OFFICE WAS DISCUSSED. AFTER SOME CONSIDERATION THE COMMISSION REQUESTED
MR. ECHOLS AND CHIEF CROSS TO MAKE A LIST OF PLACES IN THE CITY NEEDING
NEW STREET LIGHTS.

MAYOR CAMPBELL REPORTED ON STREET SURFACING.

THE FIRE HYDRANT FOR THE NEW SCHOOL WAS DISCUSSED. THE COMMISSION WAS
OF THE OPINION THAT THE SCHOOL SHOULD MAKE THE REQUEST TO THE BROOKINGS
WATER COMPANY FOR INSTALLATION OF THE FIRE HYDRANT.

A PLAN FOR A CARPORT ADDITION TO THE LEONARD BUILDING NOW OCCUPIED AS
A GREYHOUND BUS DEPOT WAS PRESENTED. AFTER CAREFUL CONSIDERATION A
MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. MOLINO THAT THE PLAN BE APPROVED AND A BUILDING
PERMIT ISSUED IF MR. HOLTE DID NOT ENCROACH UPON THE CITY STREET.
THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY MR. LORING. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. LORING AND SECONDED BY MR. TOWNSEND TO ADJOURN.
