MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING

OF THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

HELD MAY 19, 1959

THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION MET IN SPECIAL SESSION ON MAY 19, 1959, AT 8:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN ROBERT STANHURST. PRESENT WERE CHAIRMAN STANHURST, ARCHIE MCVAY, JOHN MOLINO, GORDON OLSEN, ED DEMPSEY AND HARVEY FOSTER.

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING HELD ON MAY 5, 1959, WERE READ AND APPROVED.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED FOR THE PURPOSE OF HOLDING A HEARING ON THE REZONING OF TAX LOT 19A OF THE ARNOLD TRACT FROM R-1 TO ZONE C-1. THERE BEING NO WRITTEN OR ORAL OBJECTIONS TO THE REZONING, A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. MCVAY AND SECONDED BY MR. MOLINO THAT A RECOMMENDATION BE GIVEN THE CITY COUNCIL TO REZONE TAX LOT 19A FROM R-1 TO ZONE C-1. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

THERE WAS CONSIDERABLE DISCUSSION ON THE GRADE OF EASY STREET.

A LETTER DATED MAY 7, 1959, SIGNED BY J. ARNOLD MORRIS AND A PLAT ON PROPERTY OWNED BY HIM WAS PRESENTED. A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. MCVAY AND SECONDED BY MR. MOLINO THAT THE TIDE ROCK MEADOWS PLAT BE APPROVED. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

A LETTER DATED APRIL 13, 1959, FROM R. W. HENDRICK REQUESTING THE COMMISSION TO NAME A STRIP OF PROPERTY, USED AS A ROAD OFF OF SEVENTH STREET WHICH GIVES ACCESS TO HIS PROPERTY, WAS PRESENTED. THE COMMISSION DECIDED THAT SINCE IT WAS A PRIVATELY OWNED ROAD THEY HAD NO AUTHORITY TO NAME THE ROAD.

RECOMMENDATION NO. 58:

A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. OLSEN AND SECONDED BY MR. MOLINO THAT RECOMMENDATION BE GIVEN THE CITY COUNCIL TO INVESTIGATE THE CLOSURE OF UPPER FIFTH STREET. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. MCVAY AND SECONDED BY MR. MOLINO THAT THE MEETING BE ADJOURNED.
