THE MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON MAY 20 WERE READ AND CONTENTS NOTED.

RECOMMENDATION NO. 59:

THE REZONING OF THE CARSON-MOORE MILL PROPERTY WAS DISCUSSED. A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. MCVAY AND SECONDED BY MR. MOLINO THAT A RECOMMENDATION BE GIVEN THE CITY COUNCIL TO REZONE THE CARSON-MOORE MILL PROPERTY FROM M-1 TO R-3. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

MR. McVay presented a drawing given to him by Owen Brown which would give the city a forty foot road to be an extension of Pioneer Road to Meadow Lane. The commission requested that the city engineer check the drawing and make further investigation in the matter.
