APPROVED.


THE MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON MAY 20 WERE READ
AND CONTENTS NOTED.

RECOMMENDATION NO. 59:

THE REZONING OF THE CARSON-MOORE MILL PROPERTY WAS DISCUSSED. A MOTION
WAS MADE BY MR. McVAY AND SECONDED BY MR. MOLINO THAT A RECOMMENDATION
BE GIVEN THE CITY COUNCIL TO REZONE THE CARSON-MOORE MILL PROPERTY
FROM M-1 TO R-3. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

MR. McVAY PRESENTED A DRAWING GIVEN TO HIM BY OWEN BROWN WHICH WOULD
GIVE THE CITY A FORTY FOOT ROAD TO BE AN EXTENSION OF PIONEER ROAD
TO MEADOW LANE. THE COMMISSION REQUESTED THAT THE CITY ENGINEER
CHECK THE DRAWING AND MAKE FURTHER INVESTIGATION IN THE MATTER.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. McVAY AND SECONDED BY MR. TOWNSEND THAT THE
MEETING BE ADJOURNED.
