

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

HELD AUGUST 4, 1959

THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION MET IN REGULAR SESSION ON AUGUST 4, 1959,
AT 8:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN STANHURST. PRESENT WERE
JOHN MOLINO, ALDEN LORING, GORDON OLSON, R. H. TOWNSEND, ARCHIE McVAY,
O. D. ARP AND MR. YOCK.

MR. YOCK WAS PRESENT TO DISCUSS HIS SUBDIVISION PLAN. MR. ARP
REPORTED HE HAD BEEN UNABLE TO CONTACT ADJOINING PROPERTY OWNERS TO
OBTAIN TWENTY-FIVE FEET FOR A ROAD. THE MATTER WAS TABLED UNTIL THE
NEXT REGULAR MEETING.

MR. MORRIS REQUESTED THE COMMISSION'S APPROVAL TO CHANGE A FIRE ESCAPE
ON COMMERCIAL PROPERTY OWNED BY HIM. HE WAS INSTRUCTED TO CONTACT THE
BUILDING INSPECTOR SO THAT IT WOULD CONFORM WITH THE BUILDING CODE.

THE TRAFFIC PROBLEM ALONG CHETCO AVENUE WAS DISCUSSED AT LENGTH. THE
MAYOR AGREED TO CONTACT A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPART-
MENT TO FIND OUT THE PROPER CHANNELS TO APPROACH IN REGARD TO THE
PROBLEM.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. McVAY AND SECONDED BY MR. TOWNSEND TO ADJOURN.
