MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

OF THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

JUNE 7, 1960

THE BROOKINGS PLANNING COMMISSION MET IN REGULAR SESSION JUNE 7, 1960, AT 8:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY VICE-CHAIRMAN, JOHN MOLINO. PRESENT WERE JACK HOLTE, AND ARCHIE MCVAY.

MR. CLIVE MANLEY WANTED TO KNOW IF THE PIECE OF PROPERTY OFF CHETCO AVENUE IN BLOCK ELEVEN IN THE ORIGINAL TOWNSITE NOW BEING USED AS AN ALLEY WAS CONSIDERED AS CITY PROPERTY OR DID IT BELONG TO PRIVATE PROPERTY.

MR. E. H. ECHOLS STATED THAT HE WOULD INVESTIGATE AND REPORT BACK TO MR. MANLEY.

MR. ARP REFERRED TO THE ORIGINAL PLAT OF THE BALDRIDGE PROPERTY IN THE DAWSON TRACT AND STATED THAT THE PROPERTY OWNERS WOULD GIVE BUILDING SET-BACKS OF 30 FEET. MR. ARP THEN SHOWED THE PLANNING COMMISSION A PLAT SHOWING THE LAY-OUT OF THE PROPOSED ROADS AND STREETS.

MR. DOBYN PRESENTED A PRELIMINAY PLAT FOR IVAN SMITH ON THE CORNER OF THIRD & RANSOM STREETS, LOTS Nos. 58, 59, 60, 61, & 62. FOR APPROVAL AND EVENTUALLY TO BE ZONED.

THE COMMISSION AGREED TO REIMBURSE MR. HOLTE FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN SECURING SIGNATURES OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS IN SEWER DISTRICT No. 10 WHILE IN PORTLAND OVER THE WEEK END, ESPECIALLY ANY NOTARY FEES.

Archie McVay Moved that the Planning Commission adjourn until 8:00 p.m. Wednesday evening June 8, 1960. Seconded by Jack Holte. Motion carried.
