

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

HELD JANUARY 5, 1960

THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION MET IN REGULAR SESSION ON JANUARY 5, 1960,
AT 8:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN STANHURST. PRESENT WERE
MR. LORING, JOHN MOLINO, GORDON OLSEN, MR. ECHOLS, MRS. WASHBURN AND
MARJORIE BARRETT.

THE MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING HELD ON NOVEMBER 17 AND THE REGULAR
MEETING HELD ON DECEMBER 1, 1959, WERE READ AND APPROVED.

THE COMMISSION THEN PROCEEDED TO HOLD A HEARING ON THE VACATION OF AN
ALLEY IN BLOCK 3, PLAT #1. THERE BEING NO ONE PRESENT TO OBJECT TO
THE VACATION OF THE ALLEY EXTENDING FROM CHETCO AVENUE TO COTTAGE
STREET, BOUNDED ON THE EASTERLY SIDE BY LOTS 8 THROUGH 18, BLOCK 3,
AND BOUNDED ON THE WESTERLY SIDE BY LOTS 6, 7 AND 19 OF BLOCK 3,
PLAT #1, A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. MOLINO THAT A RECOMMENDATION BE
GIVEN TO THE COUNCIL TO VACATE THE ALLEY. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED
BY MR. LORING. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

MRS. WASHBURN PRESENTED PLANS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF AN A & W ROOT BEER
DRIVE-IN FOR APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSION. A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR.
OLSEN AND SECONDED BY MR. MOLINO THAT THE TYPE OF BUSINESS AND THE
LOCATION OF THE BUSINESS BE APPROVED. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

MR. ECHOLS REQUESTED THAT THE COMMISSION CONSIDER OBTAINING A SMALL
PART OF TAX LOT 2200-41-13-6AB FROM LYLE VAUGHAN FOR STREET PURPOSES
THAT A JOG ON FIFTH STREET COULD BE ELIMINATED. A MOTION WAS MADE
BY MR. MOLINO AND SECONDED BY MR. OLSEN THAT THE COMMISSION TAKE THE
NECESSARY ACTION TO OBTAIN THIS PROPERTY FOR STREET PURPOSES. MOTION
CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

MR. ECHOLS PRESENTED A MAP ON PROPERTY OWNED BY O. E. DAVIS OUTLING
A STREET HE WANTED TO DEED TO THE CITY. AFTER CONSIDERABLE DISCUSSION,
THE SECRETARY WAS INSTRUCTED TO WRITE A LETTER TO MR. DAVIS REQUESTING
HIM TO BE PRESENT AT THE NEXT REGULAR MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION
FOR FURTHER DISCUSSION OF THE STREET.

A PETITION SIGNED BY TEN RESIDENTS ALONG TANBARK ROAD REQUESTING
INSTALLATION OF A STREET LIGHT ON TANBARK ROAD WAS PRESENTED. THE
SECRETARY WAS INSTRUCTED TO WRITE TO THE PETITIONERS INFORMING THEM
THAT CONSIDERATION OF A STREET LIGHT IN THIS AREA IS PLANNED IN THE
NEXT BUDGET YEAR.

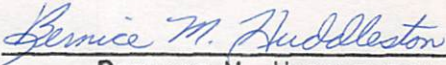
THE EXTENSION OF PIONEER ROAD ACROSS GLASS PROPERTY WAS DISCUSSED. THE COMMISSION HAS NO PLANS FOR THE EXTENSION OF PIONEER ROAD AT THIS TIME AND THE SECRETARY WAS INSTRUCTED TO NOTIFY THE GLASS' TO THIS EFFECT.

THE WIDENING OF EASY STREET WAS DISCUSSED. THE MATTER WAS TABLED UNTIL DEFINITE OWNERSHIP OF THE STREET WAS KNOWN.

OBTAINING OF MILL BEACH FOR A PARK WAS DISCUSSED. MR. LORING WAS APPOINTED TO CHECK WITH MR. BANKUS IN REGARD TO OBTAINING THE BEACH AS A PARK. MR. ECHOLS WAS INSTRUCTED TO CHECK WITH THE COUNTY ASSESSOR TO DETERMINE THE BOUNDARY OF THE PROPERTY ALONG MILL BEACH OWNED BY MR. BANKUS.

MR. OLSEN, MR. MOLINO AND MR. ECHOLS WERE APPOINTED TO WORK ON A BUDGET TO BE PRESENTED TO THE BUDGET COMMITTEE.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. MOLINO AND SECONDED BY MR. OLSEN THAT THE MEETING BE ADJOURNED.
