MINUTES OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION

JUNE 6, 1961

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 8:15 P.M. WITH CHAIRMAN ROBERT STANHURST PRESIDING:

THE MINUTES OF MAY 2, 1961 WERE READ AND APPROVED AS READ.

THE MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL MEETING OF MAY 9, 1961 WERE READ FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE COMMISSIONERS.

Mayor Campbell Stated that the County had appropriated approximately \$30,000 to be used in Road Repair and construction within the CityEs of the County and that the proportionate share of Brookings would be approximately \$13,000.

Mayor Campbell stated that he had an interview with Norman Clapp, a Representative of the REA and that he got the impression that the Brookings-Harbor District would be able to get some assistance in putting in a water system. The possibility of putting in a water system was discussed at length with the pros and cons being brought out by different members of the planning commission.

MAYOR CAMPBELL STATED THAT HE WAS VERY OPTIMISTIC WITH THE PROSPECTS OF SECURING ASSISTANCE IN THE FUTURE FOR LONG RANGE PLANNING IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADEQUATE AND SUITABLE WATER SUPPLY.

SINCE JULY FOURTH IS THE FIRST TUESDAY OF THE MONTH OF JULY IT WAS AGREED THAT THE NEXT PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING SHOULD BE HELD ON WEDNESDAY JULY 5, 1961.

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER MCVAY THAT THE MEETING BE ADJOURNED, SECONDED BY JOHN MOLINO. MOTION CARRIED.
