

MINUTES OF THE
BROOKINGS PLANNING COMMISSION
September 5, 1961

The meeting was called to order by Robert Stanhurst, Chairman.

Other Commissioners

Present were Jack Holte, John Molino, Archie McVay, Virgil Goldsberry and Ed Oar. Absent was Al Philips. Others present were Darrell Swatzel, Marge Barrett and Elmer Zwicher.

The minutes of August 1, 1961, were read and approved as read.

The first order of business was the presentation of a petition for re-zoning Fred Flynn & Darrell Salisbury property described as portions of Lots 73-74-75-76 & 77 of the un-recorded Thornton & Ward Tract. The petition requested a re-zoning from R-3 to M-1 for a moving and storage company. The petition was presented by Zwicher. After considerable discussion it was brought forth that the required percentage of owners owning the property had not signed the petition. A motion was made by Archie McVay to accept the petition for the zoning change when the petitioners had obtained the required number of signatures as set forth in Ordinance No. 19. The motion was seconded by Jack Holte. Motion passed unanimously.

The next order of business was the discussion of a secretary for the Planning Commission due to the resignation of Ralph B. Cavens. It was the consensus of opinion of the Commission to have the new City Recorder act as secretary if he would so serve.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:00 p. m.
