

MINUTES OF THE BROOKINGS PLANNING
COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING MARCH 6, 1962

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 8:00 P. M. JOHN MOLINO ACTING CHAIRMAN.
OTHER COMMISSIONERS PRESENT: JACK HOLTE, ED OAR, AL PHILLIPS, ROY BRIMM,
VIRGIL GOLDSBERRY AND ARCHIE McVAY. COMMISSIONERS ABSENT: NONE.
OTHERS PRESENT: MAYOR C. F. CAMPBELL AND REPORTER MARGE BARRETT.

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING HELD ON FEBRUARY 6, 1962,
WERE READ AND APPROVED AS READ.

A PETITION ASKING FOR VACATION OF ALLEY, SIGNED BY 100% OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS
WHOSE PROPERTY ABUTTED THE 15' ALLEY, BISECTING BLOCKS 19 AND 27, PLAT No. 1,
BROOKINGS, WAS PRESENTED BY THE SECRETARY. AFTER CONSIDERABLE DISCUSSION, IT
WAS MOVED BY COMMISSIONER GOLDSBERRY THAT THE PETITION BE ACCEPTED AND THAT
THE SECRETARY BE AUTHORIZED AND INSTRUCTED TO ADVERTISE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING
ON THE PROPOSAL, AS REQUIRED BY LAW; SAID HEARING TO BE HELD AT THE CITY HALL,
IN BROOKINGS, ON APRIL 3, 1962. MOTION SECONDED BY ARCHIE McVAY. MOTION
CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.


A REQUEST BY ARCHIE TRAPARIER, FOR INFORMATION REGARDING A PROPOSED HOBBY
SHOP WAS TABLED UNTIL SUCH TIME AS MORE INFORMATION IS PRESENTED TO THE
COMMISSION.

JOHN MOLINO WAS CHOSEN AS CHAIRMAN OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION, TO FILL THE
UNEXPIRED TERM OF ROBERT STANHURST, PAST CHAIRMAN, AND VIRGIL GOLDSBERRY WAS
SELECTED AS VICE CHAIRMAN, BOTH BY UNANIMOUS APPROVAL OF ALL MEMBERS.

A LETTER FROM THE BROOKINGS HARBOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE WAS PRESENTED, IN
WHICH THEY RECOMMENDED THAT THE CITY OF BROOKINGS SET ASIDE ADEQUATE OPEN
AREAS FOR TOURIST PARKING, ESPECIALLY FOR AUTOS PULLING TRAILERS. AFTER
A LENGTHY DISCUSSION OF THIS MATTER AND THE POSSIBLE AREAS WHERE PARKING
COULD BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THIS PURPOSE, IT WAS MOVED BY JACK HOLTE THAT THE
PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMEND (RECOMMENDATION #64) TO THE CITY COUNCIL THAT
CONSIDERATION BE GIVEN TO ESTABLISHING DAYTIME, OFFSTREET, FREE PARKING FOR
TOURISTS ON THE NORTHEASTERLY SIDE OF 5TH. STREET FRONTAGE ROAD; SAID PARKING
AREA GENERALLY PARALLELING HIGHWAY 101, BETWEEN HIGHWAY STATION 742+00 AND
745+77.18 AND THAT THIS MATTER BE TAKEN INTO EFFECT IN PLANNING FUTURE ROAD
IMPROVEMENTS AND STREET CONSTRUCTION IN SAID AREA. SECONDED BY VIRGIL GOLDS-
BERRY. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

A GENERAL DISCUSSION FOLLOWED CONCERNING THE NEED FOR TRAFFIC LIGHTS, OFFSTREET
AREA FOR STATE WEIGHMASTERS, ADVANTAGES OF ALLEYS FOR LOADING AND UNLOADING
TRUCKS AND FIRE PROTECTION. JOHN MOLINO EXPRESSED HIS APPRECIATION FOR THE
CONFIDENCE SHOWN BY THE MEMBERS IN CHOOSING HIM AS CHAIRMAN AND STATED THAT
HE WOULD WORK TO THE BEST OF HIS ABILITY FOR THE WELFARE AND PROGRESS OF THE
COMMUNITY. HE SAID THAT HE WAS GLAD TO SEE ALL MEMBERS PRESENT AND HOPED
THAT THIS WOULD BE A CONTINUING PROCEDURE IN THE FUTURE. HE ALSO SAID THAT
HE WOULD CONTROL THE MEETINGS SO THAT PLANNING MATTERS WOULD PROCEED IN AN
ORDERLY AND EFFICIENT MANNER.
