A Special meeting of the Planning Commission was called to order at 7:10 P. M. by Chairman Harley Nissen.


Members present were Ed Thornton, Jack Holte, George Dreizius, Roy Brimm, Ed Oar and Cal Gorte.

Plans for the Brookings Inn, a proposed 40 unit motel, were submitted to the Commission for approval. The proposed motel is to be located at the corner of Chetco Avenue and Arnold Lane in a C-1 zone. Owner of the proposed structure is Mr. G. S. Sheppard and the builder is the Collins Construction Co. of Roseburg. It is valued at \$215,000.00 and is expected to cover 123,489 square feet.


