Reporters present were Dick Keusink and Marge Barrett.


Minutes of the July 5 Planning Commission meeting were read and approved.

Building Inspector Lee Fountain gave the building report for the month of July. Eight permits had been issued for a total valuation of \$3,690 and a fee of \$35. No new structures were built in July.


Edith Sears appeared before the Planning Commission and presented the final plat of her proposed trailer park. Mrs. Sears pointed out that the streets now complied with the fifty-foot minimum City and County standards. George Dreizius made a motion that the final plat be approved, and that the Chairman and Secretary be authorized to sign the final plat for the official records. Jack Holte seconded the motion, and it was unanimously passed.

Considerable discussion regarding the placing of mobil homes within the City of Brookings took place. No official action was taken, however.
