

REGULAR MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION
CITY OF BROOKINGS
OCTOBER 3, 1967

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 P. M. by Chairman Jack Holte.

Members present were Gerald Ross, Robert Dimmick, Sr., Cal Gorte, Roy Brimm, and Scott Sheppard. Not in attendance was George Drizius.

Marge Barrett was the reporter present.


Building Inspector Lee Fountain gave the building report for the month of September. It showed seven permits for a total valuation of \$46,750 and a fee of \$160.50 had been issued. Two of these were for new residences.

The 1967 edition of the Uniform Building Code was discussed with the Commission. It was pointed out that there were over 600 changes from the 1964 edition now being used by the City. The Building Inspector said that the 1967 edition is basically the same as the 1964 edition, only a little more strict. Much discussion ensued regarding the adoption of this code. Cal Gorte made a MOTION that the Planning Commission recommend that the Council adopt the 1967 edition of the Uniform Building Code. Scott Sheppard seconded the motion. Commissioners Ross, Gorte, Dimmick, Sheppard, and Holte voted in favor of the motion. Commissioner Brimm voted against the motion.

Several Ordinances from Humboldt County were read and discussed. No specific action was taken on these, however.


