PUBLIC HEARINGS:

 APPLICATION FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT CU70-1 -J. J. Jozens.

The Planning Commission heard an oral report from the Building Inspector, Mr. Lee Fountain, concerning the above application by Mr. Jozens.

Applicant lives in an RL Zone and wishes to use one room in his dwelling as an architect's office. As specified in application, there will be no employees and he will comply with requirements as outlined in Article 7 Conditional Uses, Section 7.020, Subsection 5, of Brookings Zoning Ordinance No. 216, adopted July 14, 1970.

Commissioner Rush Long raised the question as to the number of vehicles this business might bring into the area thus causing a parking and traffic problem. The Building Inspector then advised that the Standards in Article 7, to which Mr. Jozens agreed, would eliminate such problems. Furthermore, Mr. Jozens said that if business increased to a point where such possibility could arise, he would move the location of his business.

The Building Inspector stated that no remonstrances

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were received from the Notice of Public Hearing mailed to property owners in the area.

No objections to the granting of conditional use permit were heard. One property owner in area, Mrs. B. Allinger, voiced her approval of the use of property as requested by Mr. Jozens.

MOTION was made by Commissioner Cal Gorte and seconded by Commissioner Ernie Christensen that Conditional Use Permit CU70-1 be allowed. Motion carried by the following roll call vote:
