A special meeting was scheduled for 3:30 p.m., June 15, 1971, for action concerning the Van Duzee Subdivision preliminary plat.

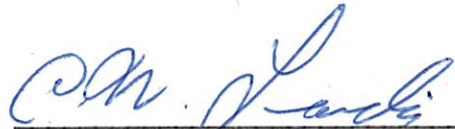
OTHER MATTERS:
