

CITY OF BROOKINGS  
PLANNING COMMISSION WORK SESSION  
JANUARY 20, 1976

Chairman called meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Discussion held on establishment of Citizens Committee for Involvement (CCI).

Upon discussion it was MOVED by Commissioner Chet Thompson that the City Planning Commission be appointed as the CCI together with an additional selection of three (3) persons from the Harbor Area and one (1) from the Northern Area outside of the City of Brookings, for a total of eleven (11) persons to undertake those planning functions mandated by LCDC. Motion seconded by Commissioner Herb Herzog and carried unanimously.

It was felt that the City should immediately advertise these positions for selection.

The citizen involvement goals were then discussed and the county resolution was evaluated and most of the items were thought to be acceptable for the Brookings Planning Area activities.

The City Council will be asked to consider this and approve.

Further discussion arose with City Manager Al Hooten explaining various activities that the city will be involved with in the future.


The Community Development Block Grant Program was discussed and Hooten explained the project did in fact address the health needs of the community and also benefits a large portion of the residential and industrial-commercial community. This directly impacts the economy of the area and aids the low income and elderly people who would normally be taxed for this water main.

The city's street improvement plans were discussed with the first "City Hall Reports" radio program to be aired this weekend.

The Commission was alerted to the probable re-numbering of houses and commercial establishments on a systematic scale that would allow for the growth that seems inevitable for this area.
